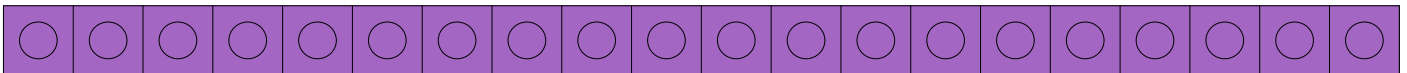

Choir Practice after school cancelled on Monday 5th December due to Xmas Fayre rescheduled to Tuesday 6th December 2016

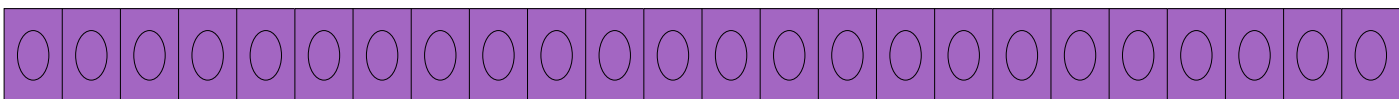
Just a reminder that after school Cheerleading and Street Dance has now finished

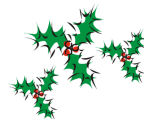

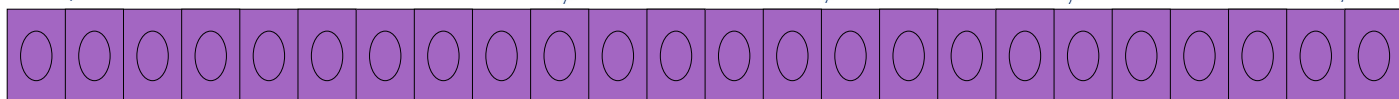
