Dear Parent/Carer,

Next half term, Year 5 children will be learning about 'Crime and Punishment' as their main Topic theme. During this Topic, they will learn more about how Crime and Punishment has changed through the ages, for example: from Medieval punishments, such as the stocks, to Victorian Work Houses. The children will also learn more about some historical cases of Crime and Punishment that occurred in Barnsley at the turn of the 20th century.

As well as in school learning, Year 5 children will be participating on a trip to the National Justice Museum, in Nottingham. We are planning to take the children to this museum on Friday 8th June 2018 and aim to leave school early so we are asking that children arrive at 8:00 am (if children are in breakfast club, they are to arrive at 8:00am as usual and come through to their classroom once they have had their breakfast.) We are aiming to arrive back at school at 4:00pm.

During the trip, in addition to completing activities within the museum, the children will participate in a workshop lead by the museum staff, where they will participate in solving a Victorian Crime using modern day CSI techniques.

We ask for a voluntary contribution of £16 towards the cost of the trip on Parent Pay. (Please feel free to pay in instalments of £4, rather than one lump sum by Friday 25th May 2018.) It is important for us to stress that in the event of an inadequate number of parental contributions it will not be possible for the trip to take place and it will be cancelled.

We also request that children wear their normal school uniform for the day and bring along a packed lunch and drink (no fizzy pop, please!) If your child is eligible for free school meals, please indicate on the slip below and we shall ensure they have a packed lunch provided on the day.
